- 1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is April 1, 2013. (No exceptions).
- 2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e. evidence of GPA, ACT Scores, essay, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will be returned to you.
- 4. Award recipients will be notified on senior awards day in May.

Purpose: In partnership with the Peabody class of 2003's reunion efforts, the class has established our very first book award program. This award has been established as a way for the class to give back to those who are soon to be graduates of our alumni institution and to provide praise and incentive for continued academic excellence.

Award Components: The class of 2003 will select two award recipients, one male and one female, to receive a book stipend that will go towards the direct costs of beginning their postsecondary career. The amount of each award will be based upon money raised through donations from the class of 2003, but will be at least \$200 each.

Award Impact: At the end of this process, at least two Peabody graduates will be better prepared to begin postsecondary pursuit. They will each gain a sense of financial support and encouragement through the efforts of those who have come before them.

Award Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating senior in high school.
- 2. Applicant must be enrolled at Peabody Magnet High School for the 2012-2013 school year
- 3. Applicant must show a proven record of academic excellence.
- Applicant must show active involvement in community service and extracurricular activities.
- 5. Applicant must have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- 6. Applicant must have obtained a 20 or higher on the ACT.
- 7. Applicant must be planning to enroll in post-secondary institution.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly).
- 2. A copy of their most recent transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 3. A copy of their ACT scores.
- 4. Personal Essay [500 word minimum; please see topics in section15]
- 5. A recent photograph or headshot

Deadline for the application is **Monday**, **April 1**, **2013**. Applications date stamped after this date will not be considered. No emailed or incomplete applications will be considered.

Announcement of Award Recipients: May, 2013

Special Provision: Scholarship funds will be issued directly to the recipient prior to the beginning of the fall semester. Proof of enrollment will be required before funds can be disbursed. Details on provision of enrollment documentation will be provided at a later date.
